Season's Greetings and warm wishes for a jubilant and constructive year ahead. As we are approaching to the end of this academic year and our 10 years of service towards providing quality education since our inception in 2012, we take this opportunity to thank the Almighty Lord for His abundant blessings and guidance from our well-wishers.

# There is a great saying: "Real education fetches you more than a job. It teaches you to live. It cannot be measured in any tangible way."

As we share the yearly updates of our activities, we take the modesty to say that we did our best to do as we had planned and we are proud of our students and teachers who strive hard to achieve beyond expectations.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS: Many elements go into making a quality learner, including health, early childhood experiences and home support. Our learners know it well that perseverance leads to confidence and confidence leads to competence. We hold the pride legacy of scoring 100% result in AISSE since last five years. In the session 2020-21 Pisupati Sricharan stood first in the school securing 96.4 % marks. In the session 2021-22, Manasvi Bhatnagar stood first in the school securing 96.4 % marks in AISSE & Ishita Agrawal stood first obtaining 92 % in AISSCE.

**CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** The development of learner's cognitive, affective and psychomotor domain is supported by the school through curricular and co-curricular activities throughout the academic session. Regular parent - teacher meetings & parent – principal interactions helped us to ensure maximum participation of parents to improve the scholastic and co-scholastic areas in school-related activities. School has taken some extra efforts to improve the quality of students' performance. Remedial Teaching Programmes are organized for students of VIII - X & XII before & after the regular school hours.

**OLYMPIADS:** The curriculum-based assessment tool allowed teachers to determine students' level of mastery of previous and current years' curricula, which helped them determine the extent to which alternative instructional strategies and remedial content were necessary for both individuals and groups. This approach resulted in significantly improved outcomes. School has been conducting these Science Olympiad Foundation sponsored

Olympiads. The young learners have shown astounding performance in this exam. The results are yet awaited.

Ishaan Dubey came up as a Position Holder of Zonal Rank in SOF (IEO): 2020-21 & secured 8th rank at regional level & international level. He has been awarded with Zonal Gold medal, gifts worth Rs. 1000/- & Certificate of Zonal Excellence on 13th March 2021. For the current session, the exams are being conducted.

Out of 135 schools our school grabbed the 3rd position in the first round and qualified for the final round. ## WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS:
